


# SPRITUAL HERITAGE TOUR 2018

**Delhi** – Attractions include a Tuk Tuk ride thru old Delhi Market, Mahatma Gandhi Memorial, Qutub Minar, Judah Hyam Synagogue for Shabbat, pass by architectural marvels of modern India like Parliament House, President House and New Delhi's India Gate, visit to Bhai Lotus Temple and famous Sikh Temple, Mahatma Gandhi Museum.

**Agra** – Visit the Taj Mahal at sunrise and tour the Red Fort and Fatehpur Sikri. Shopping and time with locals.

**Jaipur** – Elephant ride to Amber Fort, City Palace tour, Jantar Mantar (observatory built in 1734) and much more.

**Mumbai** – Visit the Gateway of India, Synagogues, Prince of Wales Museum, Shabbos with Chabad of Mumbai.

**Cochin** – Tour some of the oldest Jewish settlements, Kathakali Dance performance and visit fishing villages.

**Kumarkoam** – Overnight stay on houseboat. Try an Ayurveda oil message (optional) in the treatment center.
